1.

Reflect on Your Core Values

Ask yourself:

- ◆ What virtues matter most to me?
- ◆ What truths do I live by?
- ◆ Where do I see God's hand guiding me?

2.

Identify Your Strengths and Passions

Ask yourself:

- ◆ What brings me joy?
- ◆ What am I naturally good at?
- ◆ What problems am I drawn to solve?

3.

Define Your "Why"

Ask yourself:

- ◆ What motivates me each day?
- ◆ Who do I feel called to serve?
- ◆ How does my faith shape my purpose?

4.

Write It Out—Simply and Clearly

A good mission statement:

- ◆ Inspires action
- ◆ Reflects my values
- ◆ Guides decisions

Revisit and Refine

As life changes, so may your mission. Check in yearly—does it still reflect your heart?

Example:

"I live to nurture faith, serve with compassion and lead with courage—in my family, work and community."

Live your mission—mind, body and spirit.
